

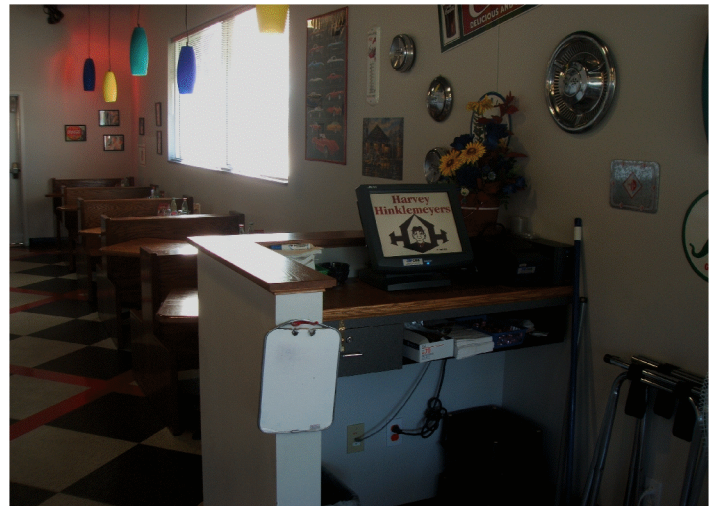
HARVEY HINKLEMEYERS KOKOMO
